

## The Godly Woman – Proverbs 31 Study Sample

Various comprehension activities, language arts exercises and application assignments make up this study of Proverbs 31. Below are just a few of the suggested activities. Worksheets and a booklet for illustration accompany this study.

- 1) Using the pre-printed passage included here, go through the passage and underline all the action verbs or verb phrases in the passage in blue. Copy those verbs or phrases onto the verb list worksheet. Talk about what those verbs mean. Come up with at least one synonym and one antonym for each verb listed. (There are approximately 40, depending on the level of grammar study your child has had and how they classify verbs at their level.)
- 2) Looking at the passage about the excellent or godly or noble wife can be a bit intimidating. It is also a temptation to look at “works” or “things to do” to be good or godly. But that is not the point of this passage. It is more important that we spend time evaluating what this woman’s character is like, not what her actions are. The actions of every woman will be different, depending on the path that God leads her on – but we can all develop the character qualities that are commended in this passage. Use the Character Qualities Worksheet to think about what this woman is like – not just what she does.
- 3) Have an older student write a paraphrase of this passage, modernizing the illustrations to the present day.
